### **Event Description**

Lit Magic is an inter-college literary event, organised by the School of Linguistics and Literary Studies at Chinmaya Vishwavidyapeeth, and coordinated by the 1<sup>st</sup>- and 2<sup>nd</sup>-year English literature students. This exciting fest will be held on Dec 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The main motive of this event is to raise awareness about the relevance and beauty of literature, through various activities and games. There are 6 events in all, with most organised for college students, except one where school students can participate. Some events are live events, while others require prepared submissions.

The fest is entirely online, so you can participate from anywhere! And don't forget, registration is free, and there are exciting prizes to be won!

Here are the events that Lit Magic brings to you this year:

- Quiz for the Quixotic (Quiz)
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### **1. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- Participants should register using the **Google form link** given in the posters ([bit.ly/litmagic21](https://bit.ly/litmagic21))
- Once you complete the form, we will send you the instructions for all the competitions you have enrolled in.
- For the live competitions, students must join the Zoom meeting **15 minutes before the event start time.**
- For the recorded competitions, students should submit their videos before the deadline.
- For the live competitions, make sure that your network connection is good. No special consideration will be given in case of disconnection.
- Participants must clearly mention their age group/participation category for each event that they wish to participate in.
- The decisions of the judges will be final and binding.
- Participants must strictly adhere to the general rules of the host college.
- Any misbehaviour will lead to the disqualification of the whole team from a particular event.
- Chinmaya Vishwavidyapeeth retains the right to change the prize amount and the schedule at any point prior to the start of the fest.

## **2. EVENT-SPECIFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **Lit Maze (Treasure Hunt)**

- Any number of students from a college can participate.
- A team must consist of **2 members**
- Age: **18 – 25**
- There will be a total of **3 rounds**
- The first 2 rounds will be conducted on **Dec 4<sup>th</sup> at 10.00 am to 11.30am**  
(Break will be given after the 1<sup>st</sup> round)
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> round is on the same day at **2.00 pm**
- **Round 1 :-**
  - Solve a puzzle (puzzle contains a famous literary character) and identify the literary work
    - \*The link to the puzzle would be provided and each group can individually access and solve it.
  - Solve the puzzle; the top 10 groups will be selected for the next round.
  - Evaluation is based on the time taken.
- **Round 2:-**
  - Identify the mythical creatures found in literary works.
    - \*A PPT will be prepared with one mythical character in each slide. Participants should identify the characters.
  - This round will be assessed based on the time that each groups take to complete it. Clues will be provided if necessary.
  - Total 200 points will be provided as they enter round 2.
  - Deduction of points if the participants ask for clues, skip questions or take more time. (Score based on the above-mentioned criterion)
    - **Skip question - Deduct 20 points**
    - **Each clue - Deduct 5 points each**
    - **Time more than 3 minutes – Deduct 5 points for each additional minute**
  - The top 5 teams with the maximum scores will qualify for the next round
- **Round 3:-**
  - Identify the literary work and the author using the clues provided.

\*A PPT will be prepared containing different clues (quotes, images, character names, plot, etc.),

- The participants will be given access to the ppt. They should identify the literary work and the author from the given clues.
- The first groups to figure out the answers win.

### **Quiz for Quixotic (Quiz)**

- Any number of students from a school can participate.
- Age 14-17
- There are total of **3 rounds**
- The first 2 rounds will be through Google forms
- Round 1 will have **20 questions**, 20 min
- Round 2 will have **15 questions**, 15 min
- There will be negative marks (-0.5) for each wrong answer in the first 2 rounds
- Whoever gets the highest number of correct answers within the minimum time will be promoted to the next round.
- The first 2 rounds (qualifying) will be conducted on **Dec 3<sup>rd</sup>**
- Round 3 (Finals) will be a live section via zoom on **Dec 4<sup>th</sup> at 11.30am**
- There is no negative marking for this round.
- Whoever answers the highest number of correct answers will be winner of the quiz
- In all the rounds questions are based on general facts about literature, and grammar

### **Pantoon Tales (Cartoon Strip)**

- Any number of students from a college can participate.
- Age: 18 – 25
- The story should be a modified version of existing **fairy tales**.
- You cannot create a new fairy tale of your own but use one which is famous as well as known to all.
- Maximum numbers of panels allowed are **6** (there should not be more than 6 panels).
- Ideal range of panels is between **4 to 6**.

- You can draw the strip either on paper or in computer.
- Send your work in the form of a **pdf** (if on paper, take a clear picture and then send as pdf).
- The submission should be made by **Dec 2<sup>nd</sup>**.

### **Vaagmita (Elocution)**

- Any number of students from a college can participate.
- Age: 18 – 25
- The speech must not exceed **10 minutes**.
- The speech will be scored on the basis of the effectiveness of the points made, and the overall presentation and delivery of the speaker.
- The recorded video of the presentation should be mailed before **Dec 1<sup>st</sup>**.
- While recording don't **pause and resume** the video, such videos will be **disqualified**.
- The topic will be sent to you via email, once you complete the registration.

### **Tell a Tale 2.0 (Story Writing)**

- Any number of students from a college can participate
- Age categories:
  - **18-25**
  - **25 above**
- We will give you a poem and you must convert it to a story. You are also free to add your creativity and imagination to the story, without losing the essence of the poem.
- The word limits for the story are as follows:
  - **Category: 18-25 years:** not less than **1000 words** and not more than **1500 words**.
  - **Category: Above 25 years:** not less than **1500 words** and not more than **2000 words**.
- The file should be sent in **.docx** or **.pdf** format, on or before **Dec 1<sup>st</sup>**.
- Please mention the category of your submission (18-25 or 25 above).
- Your submissions will undergo **plagiarism** check. If any part of the submission is found to be copied, the participant will be **disqualified**.

### Alone with None (Soliloquy)

- Any number of students from a college can participate
- Age: 18 – 25
- Participants can choose to perform a **soliloquy** from any of Shakespeare’s plays.
- The performance time should not exceed than **10 minutes**.
- You must send us a video of you performing a soliloquy, on or before **Dec 1<sup>st</sup>**.
- You must introduce yourself; include your name, age, college and which part you are taking.
